GENERAL MAINTENANCE

Vacuum cleaning is enough for everyday care of these rugs. To remove any loose dirt, you can wipe the rug with a lightly damp soft cloth in weft direction.

This kind of rugs should not be beaten or shaken. If you want to air your carpet, you should roll it loosely and place it in vertical direction on a flat surface, on an air corridor.

REMOVAL OF STAINS

Stains or spots should be removed straight away. Remember to clean gently. Any dried surface stains such as food and other protein stains should be scraped off, for instance with a sharp knife. Be careful not to damage the surface of the material. Never scrub or rub. Specially, avoid rubbing when the surface is wet. Any liquids (juice etc. water soluble liquids) spilled onto the rug surface should be dabbed immediately with a piece of white paper towel or white, absorbent cotton terry towel.

1. Wet a cotton towel with cold water and squeeze out excess water. The affected area should be treated by tapping it with a damp towel. A drop of mild washing-up liquid can also be added.
2. Rinse out by using a clean damp sponge or towel.
3. Finally dry the affected area by tapping it with dry towel and blot the moisture.
4. It's also advisable to use neutral soap wet towels such as the ones used for baby care.

WASHING

Washing process expedites wear and tear of your carpet so avoid doing it unless necessary. The best way to wash these rugs is using textile washer with steamer, steam-cleaning. The steam-cleaning washing method is gentle for the surface and texture. Use minimum moisture setting on the machine. Washing processes done by external carpet wash specialists remain under their entire responsibility.

Do not spin-dry.

Do not soak.

Do not bleach.

Do not wash and/or dry in a cylinder machine
